Draft Board Decoder

The FantasyDrafthelp.com draft board contains all the relevant information you need right at your fingertips.

* Players are color-coded by their value by round in a 12-team draft. 1st round is gold, 2nd round silver, 3rd round bronze, 4th round orange, 5th round light blue and 6th round green.

* The "EXP" column shows how players ranked on an "Experts Draft Board" compilation of other leading industry sources. The "UQB" column shows how each player performed on our standard deviation from the mean statistic in 2014 (stat details on Page 2). If a league is considered stronger than the other one at this position, it will have its initials listed (capital letters means much stronger, lower case means not so much).

* Relevant 2014 statistical categories are listed, along with rankings for each, the number of games played and rankings in the aforementioned "UQB" category (UQB numbers in bold indicate that the player was higher than the statistical mean in every one of the measured categories). \$\$ provides the dollar value for a mixed-value auction, while \$ provides the dollar value for a single-league auction.

Evaluating Production Across a Spectrum: Lessons of our Proprietary Ultimate Quantitative Baseline Stat

Our "UQB" category (Ultimate Quantitative Baseline) on our draft board calculates the standard deviation from the mean in all relevant hockey categories. In simple English, imagine a spectrum going across from left to right, with negative numbers on the left side, a "zero" in the middle and positive numbers on the right.

We utilize this statistic for football, hockey, basketball, hoops and NASCAR as well as baseball. For baseball, we use all of the standard fantasy categories listed on the draft board to factor in for this statistical compilation. A player's performance in each category is plotted on one of these spectrums, with the most valuable players putting up most of their numbers on the most of their numbers on the positive side. Then, we add up the totals of every category, positive and negative. By using this tool, we can identify not merely how they performed, but how valuable their performances were in each category. Truly, this statistic serves as the ultimate baseline for the previous season's production.

Suggested League Guidelines

Unless you are a first-time participant, you have either played rotisserie baseball (a game in which players accrue points based on their performance in different categories) or fantasy baseball (a game in which different achievements earn various amounts of points). Here are our recommended formats for each (keeping in mind that for each format, if you have less than 10 owners, you should utilize a single-league format — and regardless of anything else, use a \$100 Free Agent Acquisition Budget, or FAAB, to allow for distribution of players):

^ Rotisserie baseball: We urge you to use the standard 5X5 setup, in which BA, HR, SB, Runs and RBI are used for hitters and Wins, Saves, WHIP, ERA and Ks are used for pitchers (4X4 leagues drop Runs and Ks). For example, if you are in a 12-team league, the team scoring highest in each category earns 12 points, on down to the lowest team earning 1 point. Rotisserie baseball is traditionally associated more with the auction format, which works well here. Each player is given \$260 of figurative money to purchase 23 players (2C, 1 1B, 1 2B, 1 SS, 1 3B, 5 OF, 1 CI, 1 MI, 1 Utility, 7 SP, 2 RP), with a 5-round standard serpentine draft afterwards to fill out a taxi squad.

^ Rotisserie/fantasy hybrid: This is probably our favorite form of competition, because it combines the traditional roto style with head-to-head play. Each week, you play against an opponent, competing in roto categories, with the winner of the most categories taking the victory (a tiebreaking category is established as a backup). Either an auction or the standard serpentine draft format works here.

^ Fantasy baseball: These categories should be used, with the number of points awarded for each in parentheses: Single (1), Double (2), Triple (3), HR (4), Hitter K (-1), Run (1), RBI (1), SB (1), Win (10), Save (5), IP-ER (1), K (1). For this format, a standard serpentine draft is preferred.

2016 Fantasy Overview

^ As shown in the study performed by FantasyDrafthelp.com on Page 20, 2014 ranked tied for 40th on the FDH MLB Offensive Index for seasons since 1968 (the year chosen because it represents a historical high point for pitching with Bob Gibson's 1.12 ERA and the MLB batting average of .231 that necessitated the pitching mound being lowered – plus, it was the year before the leagues split into two divisions apiece for the first time). We predicated, correctly, a year ago that offense would come back a bit in 2015. Look for about the same range of production in 2016. One stat that we're always focused on is the ratio of HRs to SBs and in 2015, SBs plummeted to their lowest rate in a decade – something to monitor in 2016.

^ To further demonstrate that 2014 was an offensive outlier in this era, note that there were only 11 players with 30 HRs or more in that year. In 2015, there were 11 of them in the 30s alone, with another nine in the 40s! But this rebound should be kept in perspective: for a point of comparison, in 2000 – the height of the steroid area with 2.34 HR/gm – there were 16 players with 40 or more HR and there were 47 players with 30 or more HR!

^ We are always additionally focused on the pool of available talent at the positions of greatest scarcity: catcher, second basemen and shortstops. The absolute plummeting of power in the game has taken its toll the most at the middle infield spots and this year, the pool of available starters and second-tier players is very thin. If you get shut out at those spots, getting caught on the wrong end of a run will be very damaging. The catcher position is deeper in both areas.

^ The greater emphasis on strikeouts, with new records having been set or tied in baseball every year since 2007 (!), is actually diminishing the importance of power pitchers as a whole somewhat – aside from the absolute most dominant ones. You still don't want to try to win a title without top strikeout hurlers, but you can be a bit more patient in trying to accrue them.

^ As always, dual-eligible players are of great importance. This year, they comprise four of the top 66 players overall.

Tracing Offense In Baseball – From Before The Steroid Era Until Now

We at FantasyDrafthelp.com have been tracing offensive trends in baseball since we opened shop in 2006 and even longer than that, as part of the Drafthelp.com mothership previously. But the 2006 season stands out in particular when it comes to our track record, because FDH Director of Research Nate Noy indicated that there would be consequences statistically in terms of the new amphetamine testing.

Of course, “greenies” had been a well-established part of the game for several decades and Nate predicated that less-alert players (keeping in mind that even hyper-caffeinated drinks would not come close to matching the effects of speed) would be far less likely to be able to keep up with the high heat. As the chart to the right indicates, he was absolutely right, with KO/Gm rising from 12.61 in 2005 to 15.41 in 2014 and 2015.

Beyond that correct prediction, however, we wanted to keep digging in light of the crash of offense in baseball in 2014. How much, exactly, had batting fallen off since the steroid era? And what had been the ebbs and flows of the game going even further back?

We created an FDH offensive metric (the first column of the chart) by adding totaling up the spreads of the bolded categories (HR/Gm, Runs/Gm, BA, ERA and WHIP) going back to “The Year of the Pitcher” (and the year before baseball split into divisions for the first time ever, 1968). As such, we found that 2014 was tied for 40th-highest of the 48 seasons since 1968, falling from 36th in 2013, and tied for 27th (relatively close to middle-of-the-pack in 2012). 2015, as we predicted in this very space last year, represented a slight bounceback to 34th.

Clearly, baseball has had a few distinct eras in terms of offensive production since 1968: 1968-72 (a strong pitching era, with 1970 as an outlier), 1973-92 (a moderate offensive era with 1976, 1981 and 1987 as outliers), 1993-2000 (the first half of the steroid era, which built to a crescendo), 2001-09 (the second half of the steroid era, with offense receding slightly in the reverse of the previous period) and 2010-15 (much less offense than the steroid era, similar to 1973-92 aside from 2014 being a pitching-dominated slight outlier).

By all indications historically, the dearth of offense has gone about as far as it’s going to go and the pendulum should start swinging back the other way. However, major jumps in the FDH statistic are pretty rare from year to year, so the most logical expectation for 2016 is very little change, with perhaps the tiniest bit of additional offense again if there is any movement. A chart like this is great fun for any true stat-lover, so it’s entirely possible that your own perusal of it will illuminate additional trends to you.
