* Players are color-coded by their value by round in a 10-team draft. 1st round is gold, 2nd round silver, 3rd round bronze, 4th round orange and 5th round light blue.

* The "Stat" column shows how each player performed on our standard deviation from the mean statistic in 2014-15 (stat details on Page 2).

* Relevant 2014-15 statistical categories are listed, along with rankings for each, the number of games played and rankings in the aforementioned "Stat" category.

* NOTE: To better reflect how leagues are now conducted, all forwards are rated together, albeit with positional notations.

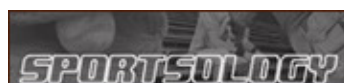

Evaluating Production Across a Spectrum: Lessons Of Our Proprietary Ultimate Quantitative Baseline Stat

Our "UQB" category (Ultimate Quantitative Baseline) on our draft board calculates the standard deviation from the mean in all relevant hockey categories. In simple English, imagine a spectrum going across from left to right, with negative numbers on the left side, a "zero" in the middle and positive numbers on the right side. We utilize this statistic for football, baseball, basketball, hoops and NASCAR as well as hockey. For hockey, we use all of the standard fantasy categories listed on the draft board to factor in for this statistical compilation.

A player's performance in each category is plotted on one of these spectrums, with the most valuable players putting up most of their numbers on the most of their numbers on the positive side.

Then, we add up the totals of every category, positive and negative. By using this tool, we can identify not merely how they performed, but how valuable their performances were in each category.

Truly, this statistic serves as the ultimate baseline for the previous season's production.

Media Notes From The NHL Awards

At the 2015 NHL Awards Media Day in Las Vegas, when asked what the focus is for next year, Alain Vigneault indicated that there is some work to be done first before things come into focus. “We’re in that stage now where we just got through the emotions of losing the way we did, and now we’re trying to analyze without that emotion what needs to be done...we know the cap now, we have the draft to get through, free agency, we’ll look at our young players in Hartford and we’ll make the right decisions for our team when those pieces come together.”

Vigneault went on to say that Mats Zuccarello is on target to be 100% by early August and he commended his training and medical staffs for their outstanding work.

Jonathan Toews opened up when asked about anticipating teammates signing with other teams or being traded in the coming weeks. “It can be challenging because we have to shift from celebrating our success to potentially facing a very emotional time if we lose guys we consider our friends; it’s the unfortunate side of the business that we have to deal with, we don’t necessarily get used to it, but we’re reminded that this is a business.”

John Tavares believes that loyal Islanders fans will travel to Barclays Center to support their team. “I do think they will come; if we continue to play the way we’re playing, they’ll be there to support us. We know how loyal Islanders fans are and we’re hoping to pick up some new fans in Brooklyn.”

When asked if he foresees any challenges in moving to Brooklyn, he stated that establishing a new routine will come first, such as getting acclimated to the Long Island Railroad instead of a short drive from Garden City to the Nassau Coliseum.

^ As was the case last year, three defensemen really stand out above the rest. If you can’t get Duncan Keith, Erik Karlsson or PK Subban, then wait a few rounds and get your firepower at forward.

^ There is tremendous “real hockey” synergy with several of the top fantasy forwards and defensemen. There are two Penguins in the top five on our board and four in the top 27, two Ducks in the top four, two Canadiens in the top 15, two Stars in the top 18, two Wings in the top 24, two Lightning in the top 26 and two Avs in the top 28. Pay attention to the high-end firepower on these teams.

^ The best hope for balance this year is to grab at least one defenseman (if you can get one of the aforementioned three) and/or a goalie in the first three rounds. But there is enough depth at goalie that you may be able to wait a little bit.

Suggested League Guidelines

We recommend that you hold your auction or serpentine-style draft with 10 owners, selecting 18 players (6 defensemen, 3 goalies, 3 left wings, 3 centers, 3 right wings). In case of an auction, use a financial system that allots an average of \$11 per player.

Our preferred style of play is head-to-head roto, in which teams compete on a week-to-week head-up basis. Recommended categories are points, goals, assists, penalty minutes and plus-minus for forwards and defensemen and wins, least losses, shutouts, goals-against-average and save percentage for goalies. A rotating tiebreaker category should be utilized in the case of a 5-5 category tie. The starting lineup should consist of 2 goalies, 2 left wings, 2 centers, 2 right wings and 4 defensemen.

Don't Be That Guy

At your draft or auction, Don't Be That Guy who:

^ Doesn't properly understand his league's scoring system. Have the specific parameters down before you go to select your players.

^ Relies on a publication such as The Hockey News that doesn't have a draft board. Can you imagine such a thing?

^ Gets caught at the tail end of a run at a position: specifically, #2 defensemen should not be confused with the #1s.

^ Doesn't put enough emphasis on goal-scorers as opposed to assist-talliers. As is always the case in fantasy sports, scarcity leads to value.
