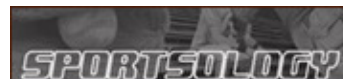

* Players are color-coded by their value by round in a 10-team draft. 1st round is gold, 2nd round silver, 3rd round bronze, 4th round orange and 5th round light blue.

* The "Stat" column shows how each player performed on our standard deviation from the mean statistic in 2015-16 (stat details on Page 2).

* Relevant 2015-16 statistical categories are listed, along with rankings for each, the number of games played and rankings in the aforementioned "Stat" category.

* NOTE: To better reflect how leagues are now conducted, all forwards are rated together, albeit with positional notations.

Evaluating Production Across a Spectrum: Lessons Of Our Proprietary Ultimate Quantitative Baseline Stat

Our "UQB" category (Ultimate Quantitative Baseline) on our draft board calculates the standard deviation from the mean in all relevant hockey categories. In simple English, imagine a spectrum going across from left to right, with negative numbers on the left side, a "zero" in the middle and positive numbers on the right side.

We utilize this statistic for football, baseball, basketball, hoops and NASCAR as well as hockey.

For hockey, we use all of the standard fantasy categories listed on the draft board to factor in for this statistical compilation.

A player's performance in each category is plotted on one of these spectrums, with the most valuable players putting up most of their numbers on the most of their numbers on the positive side.

Then, we add up the totals of every category, positive and negative. By using this tool, we can identify not merely how they performed, but how valuable their performances were in each category.

Truly, this statistic serves as the ultimate baseline for the previous season's production.

Celebrating The Legacy of Team USA And The 1996 World Cup Of Hockey

If you're a Canadian, you may want to click off this article. This fall, the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame will be inducting the 1996 World Cup of Hockey team. Other than the "Miracle on Ice" team, they're the next most important team in USA Hockey history, in my estimation.

Nobody needs a recap of the series, but the impact of it is everlasting. When Eric Lindros first joined the New York Rangers and became a teammate of Mike Richter, he mentioned the series and how impossible it was to score on the athletic netminder.

Brian Leetch was the captain. He was in the prime of his career. He was sixth in scoring during the tournament netting seven points in seven games -- a typical Leetch stat line for a tournament. "Everybody went into that tournament with a belief in our lines and defensive pairings," said Leetch. "We came together. We needed great performances and we got that."

Brett Hull was the tournament high scorer with 11 points, John LeClair was second with 10. Keith Tkachuk had five goals in seven games but had 44 PIM. He played his role to perfection. "We never felt overmatched by anybody else's lineup. We had the best goalie in the tournament in Mike Richter."

Canada was heavily favored in the best-of-three tournament. Wayne Gretzky, Steve Yzerman, Paul Coffey, Lindros, Mark Messier and Martin Brodeur were a part of this star-studded team.

One of the keys to the win was the strength of the Team USA blueline. "Brian Leetch played unbelievable," said the head coach at the time, Ron Wilson. "The two Hatchers as well. Schneider was the worst defenseman we had by comparison. We had such depth."

The rest of the defense was comprised of Phil Housley, Chris Chelios, and Gary Suter. It's fair to say it might take another decade for Team USA to field a group with that kind of talent. It was their time. "It's a nice feeling now. When you're going through it, you're focused on the event," Leetch added.

This game has had an impact on some of today's stars who are getting ready to sharpen their skates for this year's version of the tournament. "Patrick Kane and Zach Parise talked about watching this on television with their parents. For us, it's something we're definitely proud of," Leetch said.

Even if Team USA wins this year's tournament, it still won't compare to the 1996 win. It can't and it's not even fair to try to connect those dots. This was a time in history where Flyers fans were rooting for a member of the New York Rangers (who grew up in Philadelphia) and it was unifying. LeClair, a member of the "Legion of Doom" line, was now getting cheered in New York.

Nothing beats a great world hockey tournament. It can really bring out everybody's nationalistic pride.

2016-17 Fantasy Overview

^ There's a bit more depth on the blue line than last year in the top tier, but the dropoff from the top tier to the second one is significant, so try to get one of those top eight.

^ The depth at goalie is weaker in the second and third-tier levels than it was a year ago, so you may not be able to wait until late in your draft to complete your work there.

^ The top tier of forwards is deeper than in most years, so you have the opportunity to diversify at other positions in the first few rounds.

Suggested League Guidelines

We recommend that you hold your auction or serpentine-style draft with 10 owners, selecting 18 players (6 defensemen, 3 goalies, 3 left wings, 3 centers, 3 right wings). In case of an auction, use a financial system that allots an average of \$11 per player.

Our preferred style of play is head-to-head roto, in which teams compete on a week-to-week head-up basis. Recommended categories are points, goals, assists, penalty minutes and plus-minus for forwards and defensemen and wins, least losses, shutouts, goals-against-average and save percentage for goalies. A rotating tiebreaker category should be utilized in the case of a 5-5 category tie. The starting lineup should consist of 2 goalies, 2 left wings, 2 centers, 2 right wings and 4 defensemen.

We suggest that you hold a standard serpentine draft with five or six owners, with each drafting six forwards, four defensemen and two goalies. For forwards and defensemen, point totals are awarded as follows: 10 points per goal, 5 points per assist, 1 point per PIM and 2 points per Plus/Minus number in each game. In terms of bonus points, an additional 2 are awarded for power play points and assists, an additional 5 are awarded for shorthanded goals and assists and an additional 10 are awarded for a hat trick.

For goalies, 12 points are awarded per win. In terms of bonus points, an additional 5 points are awarded per shutout, an additional 10 points are awarded for winning the semifinal game and an additional 15 points are awarded for winning the gold medal game.

^ Finland: It's the usual story for this squad in high-level international play: very little offensive pop, but top-shelf two-way play and staunch goaltending. This time, it will fall just short of the "medal round."
