We at FantasyDrafthelp.com always emphasize the wisdom of our VIP approach to drafting: information and process lead to value. Of course, value is the single most important component of drafting or auctions. Even in the fantasy industry, this point is often overlooked.

In most cases, titles are won by patiently accruing value throughout a draft or auction.

During the Information stage, fantasy owners compile information about players at individual positions. Process involves comparison of players across all of the positions.

We put a tremendous amount of hard work into our draft board, and you do as well. As such, you need to trust the fruits of these labors and adhere to your draft board as much as possible. The surest way to be able to extract maximum value is to prepare extensively ahead of time and then refrain from jumping around on the board on Draft Day. Approach the draft with an actuarial mindset, determined to squeeze maximum value out of every pick, and you will be poised for success.

Draft Board Decoder

The FantasyDrafthelp.com draft board contains all the relevant information you need right at your fingertips. For example, in terms of QB, RB, WR and TE:

^ Players are color-coded by their value by round in a 12-team draft. 1st round is gold, 2nd round silver, 3rd round bronze, 4th round orange and 5th round light blue.

^ The "Exp" column displays where each player placed in an "experts consensus board" of top fantasy magazines and websites.

^ The "Stat" column shows how each player performed on our standard deviation from the mean statistic in 2019 (stat details on Page 4).

^ 2020 yardage and TD totals are listed, along with rankings for each and rankings in the aforementioned "Stat" category. Also, as a new to the WR and TE boards, "CAT%" measures the completion percentage of targets to each player.

^ "Bye" denotes each player's bye week.

Many leagues start 1 QB, 2 RB, 2 WR, 1 TE, 1 K and some D/ST combination. Some leagues allow the TE position to be WR or TE (in which case, only a few TEs merit any consideration) and some have a "flex" position, which is generally 1 additional RB or WR. With leagues who utilize defense, some deploy a team D/ST unit and some use individual D players.

The most common scoring system is a variation of the following: 4 points per passing TD, 1 point per 25 yards passing, 1 point per passing 2-point PAT, 6 points per receiving or rushing TD, 1 point per 10 yards rushing or receiving, 2 points per rushing or receiving 2-point PAT, 2 points per "big play touchdown" (50 or more yards), 1 point per kicking PAT, 3 points per FG, with a 1-point bonus at 45 yards, a 2-point bonus at 50 yards and a 3-point bonus at 55 yards, 6 points per defensive or special teams TD, 1 point per interception, sack or fumble recovered and 2 points per safety. In leagues that award 6 points for passing TDs, QBs are worth much more.

Evaluating Production Across a Spectrum: Lessons of "The Stat"

Our "Stat" category on our draft board calculates the standard deviation from the mean in all statistical categories.

In simple English, imagine a spectrum going across from left to right, with negative numbers on the left side, a "zero" in the middle and positive numbers on the right side. We utilize this statistic for baseball, basketball, hockey and NASCAR as well as football. A player's performance in each category is plotted on one of these spectrums, with the most valuable players putting up most of their numbers on the most of their numbers on the positive side. Then, we add up the totals of every category, positive and negative. By using this tool, we can identify not merely how they performed, but how valuable their performances were in each category. Truly, this statistic serves as the ultimate baseline for the previous season's production.

Fantasy Over-Under Game & Draft Board

We've come up with yet another permutation on the fantasy football experience at FantasyDrafthelp.com: the Fantasy Over-Under Game. It's based on the projected win totals released every year by the sports books.

For our game, ideally, you have four owners with three standard serpentine rounds. Each owner will take a team to finish either over or under their projected win total. The teams listed on our draft board to the right are considered by us to be the ones most likely to go over or under their projected totals by a decent amount.

Here's the scoring system:

- ^ Correct by 5 or more games: 25 points
- ^ Correct by 3-4 games: 16 points
- ^ Correct by 2 games: 7 points
- ^ Correct by 1 game: 4 points
- ^ Right on the win total: 0 points
- ^ Incorrect by 1 game: -4 points
- ^ Incorrect by 2 games: -7 points
- ^ Incorrect by 3-4 games: -16 points
- ^ Incorrect by 5 or more games: -25 points

^ Don't be that guy who is unprepared and whines in the mid to late rounds that everyone worth taking is already gone. They're not; you're just unprepared.

^ Don't be that guy who doesn't properly understand your league's scoring system. League setups are like snowflakes; no two are the same. Our draft board is configured to conform to a fairly basic scoring system, but your league could have some quirks that would force you to make adaptations to our board. Be aware.

^ Don't be that guy who doesn't pay enough attention and selects players who are already off the board. It's impolite to your teammates and it will invariably break your concentration when everyone howls at you and you've got to go back to Square One on a backup pick. To ensure that you are aware of everything that is going on during your draft, utilize a "grid" to track all teams, with the number of rounds going down the left side and the teams listed along the top.

^ Don't be that guy who approaches the draft like it's a night of epic decision-making. If you've done your homework, it's not. You merely find out where you're drafting and you "let the draft come to you."

^ Even more so than in 2019, depth at WR is a bit deeper than RB in the early-to-mid rounds, so plan accordingly.

^ As it was in 2018 and 2019, depth at both #1 QB and #2 QB is very good. Getting two backups maximizes the chance of having the options that you really want – including possible trade bait.

^ TE remains top-heavy in terms of available options. If you don't get one of the top 5 players, just wait and try to obtain 2 backups.

2021 NFL Draft Preview

First the obvious caveat: a truncated college football season (with some conferences in the fall and/or some in the spring) or no college football season will really scramble the evaluation process like nothing before ever has. And of course, no top prospects will be playing in a spring season. But, going with what we know ...

If the present Coronavirus crisis hasn't taught us all that you can't take anything for granted, go back to 2019 and ponder the assumption that Miami would tank for Tua Tagovailoa. First of all, the team showed tremendous signs of life with one of the worst rosters on paper in recent league history en route to a 5-11 record (including a December upset of New England that served as the beginning of the end of the Brady-Belichick era) and then suffered a devastating hip injury that cast into doubt whether the Dolphins would even spend the #5 pick on him. So consider that when you assume that some team is going to tank for Clemson QB Trevor Lawrence, much less execute the plan

successfully.

At the moment, though, Ohio State QB Justin Fields looms as an outstanding consolation prize for passer-shoppers who come up short on landing Lawrence. As of now, though, the quarterback class projects as somewhat thin.

In terms of other skill-position players, Clemson RB Travis Etienne will come into the league with a higher upside than most at his position, but also the caveat that there's already a lot of city miles on him at this point. WR comes yet again with a tremendous cast at the top level, headlined by LSU's Jamar Chase, Alabama's Jaylen Waddle, and Justyn Ross from Clemson. The best player serving as protection for his team's skill players projects as one of the best in recent memory, Oregon OT Penei Sewell.

Defensively, pass rushers and lockdown corners are always the players most in demand, and 2021 will have a good number of them: DEs Xavier Thomas of Clemson, Greg Rousseau of Miami and Micah Parsons of Penn State and CBs Shaun Wade of Ohio State (the latest in a long line from Corner State), Patrick Surtain Jr. of Alabama and Tyson Campbell of Georgia.

2020 FDH UQB Team Stat

For well over a decade now, FantasyDrafthelp.com has featured the UQB, or Ultimate Quantitative Baseline, as the most accurate measure of what a player achieved the previous season in fantasy production. The FDH Lounge now has a non-fantasy version of this statistic for team production: the most accurate version of how good, or bad, a given team was during the previous season. The 2019 UQB counts for 60% of this one, along with 20% for the 2020draft and 20% for the 2020 non-draft offseason.

Our core UQB statistic simply adds together the ranking of 10 different indexes: The FDH Lounge final power rankings for 2019, The FDH Lounge rankings for impressiveness of victories (based equally on a team's victories and the strength of the schedule that they played), offensive yards gained, defensive yards allowed, DVOA, Offensive DVOA, Defensive DVOA, Special Teams DVOA, The FDH Lounge 2019 NFL Draft ratings and The FDH Lounge 2019 NFL offseason ratings. The lower the number, the better each team did. These numbers may surprise you in some ways and then again, they may not.
