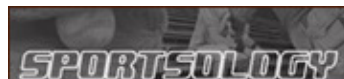

**In The Worst Year Of Our Lives, We Have An
NBA Draft Class To Match!**

In fairness to the incoming NBA draft class, the truncated NCAA hoops season did not allow any of the players the full amount of time to progress in their development. And yet, having said that, it's not a good class. At all. It's easily the most suspect class since 2013, with no "sure things."

That's not to say that there's not different tiers of talent, including by definition a top one, because there always is. But the three players atop most boards, PG LaMelo Ball (back from international play), Georgia SG Anthony Edwards and Memphis C James Wiseman all have extraordinary upside, although the question marks in their development probably would have kept the out of the Top 5 in the deep classes of 2017 and 2018. On some draft boards, Dayton PF Obi Toppin is also considered to be on that top tier, although the questions with him are different, with a much higher floor but perhaps not as high of a ceiling.

The second tier features a quadrant of intriguing PG prospects who are responsible in part for that position being the strongest unit in this year's draft: Killian Hayes (just back from France), Iowa State's Tyrese Haliburton, Alabama's Kira Lewis and North Carolina's Cole Anthony (a preseason candidate for #1 who now sits closer to the back end of the lottery). Florida State has a pair in this range as well: combo forward Patrick Williams and SG Devin Vassell. Others at this level include SF Deni Avdija (back from Israel), USC PF/C Onyeka Okongwu, Auburn SF Isaac Okoro and Vanderbilt SF Aaron Nesmith.

Preview Of FantasyDrafthelp.com Ultimate Fantasy Hoops Stat For 2020-21 Season

This is the FantasyDrafthelp.com statistic, the Ultimate Quantitative Baseline, based on the statistical principle of standard deviation from the mean. We utilize the standard fantasy categories: PPG, RPG, APG, ST, BL, TO, FG%, FT% and 3%. In each category, a spectrum is calculated from the best performance to the worst on a per-game basis. The numbers in each category are added together to create our statistic. An additional equalizer is injected to apply more points to each player at the positions of scarcer depth. What this stat truly does is to quantify beyond doubt how the stronger and weaker performances in each category add up to the absolute fantasy value for each player. As such, it establishes a baseline for performance that is more comprehensive than anything ever developed. A number over 1000 is considered elite. We have listed below the top 25 forwards and guards, top 15 centers and top 50 overall.

The 2020 NBA free agency class is nothing to write home about, with no game-changers at all – assuming that Anthony Davis either picks up his player option or signs an extension, because clearly he ain't leaving LA on the heels of his first title. And Andre Drummond will not relinquish his option either, not that he's on the same level as The Brow.

Leaving AD (and restricted free agent Brandon Ingram, who's also not going anywhere) aside, you can't even make a case for anyone in this draft being a secondary or tertiary part of any team's Big Three. Some, like SF Gordon Hayward, SG DeMar DeRozan, C Marc Gasol and PG Goran Dragic were once at that level and Dragic may still be relatively close given his play in the bubble notwithstanding being 34.
