* Players are color-coded by their value by round in a 10-team draft. 1st round is gold, 2nd round silver, 3rd round bronze, 4th round orange and 5th round light blue.

* The "Stat" column shows how each player performed on our standard deviation from the mean statistic in 2018-19 (stat details on Page 2).

* Relevant 2018-19 statistical categories are listed, along with rankings for each, the number of games played and rankings in the aforementioned "Stat" category.

* NOTE: To better reflect how leagues are now conducted, all forwards are rated together, albeit with positional notations.

Players Most Disproportionately Important In Forward-Position-Distinct Leagues

Evaluating Production Across a Spectrum: Lessons Of Our Proprietary Ultimate Quantitative Baseline Stat

Our "UQB" category (Ultimate Quantitative Baseline) on our draft board calculates the standard deviation from the mean in all relevant hockey categories. In simple English, imagine a spectrum going across from left to right, with negative numbers on the left side, a "zero" in the middle and positive numbers on the right side. We utilize this statistic for football, baseball, basketball, hoops and NASCAR as well as hockey. For hockey, we use all of the standard fantasy categories listed on the draft board to factor in for this statistical compilation. A player's performance in each category is plotted on one of these spectrums, with the most valuable players putting up most of their numbers on the most of their numbers on the positive side. Then, we add up the totals of every category, positive and negative. By using this tool, we can identify not merely how they performed, but how valuable their performances were in each category. Truly, this statistic serves as the ultimate baseline for the previous season's production.

Suggested League Guidelines

We recommend that you hold your auction or serpentine-style draft with 10 owners, selecting 18 players (6 defensemen, 3 goalies, 3 left wings, 3 centers, 3 right wings). In case of an auction, use a financial system that allots an average of \$11 per player.

Our preferred style of play is head-to-head roto, in which teams compete on a week-to-week head-up basis. Recommended categories are points, goals, assists, penalty minutes and plus-minus for forwards and defensemen and wins, least losses, shutouts, goals-against-average and save percentage for goalies. A rotating tiebreaker category should be utilized in the case of a 5-5 category tie. The starting lineup should consist of 2 goalies, 2 left wings, 2 centers, 2 right wings and 4 defensemen.

^ Doesn't properly understand his league's scoring system. Have the specific parameters down before you go to select your players.

^ Relies on a publication that doesn't have a draft board. Can you imagine such a thing?

^ Gets caught at the tail end of a run at a position: specifically, #2 defensemen should not be confused with the #1s.

^ Doesn't put enough emphasis on goal-scorers as opposed to assist-tallies. As is always the case in fantasy sports, scarcity leads to value.

As the league prepares to reach an even 32 teams in 2021-22 with Seattle's addition, it's worth examining the fruits of the 1990s expansion/relocation efforts that applied a genuine national footprint for big-time hockey for the first time ever. In the long run, it's neither the boondoggle forecast by critics nor the panacea providing a path to the mainstream that supporters promised. Instead, it's provided affiliates nationwide that have fair-weather fanbases in the vast majority of markets – similar to the plight that MLB has fallen into over the past few decades. Indeed, there are a great many similarities to be seen, almost none of them positive, when examining the silos that the NHL and MLB now occupy in the national consciousness.

Certainly, the TV situation has not been a major positive in the league's recent history. Departing the ESPN "protection racket" in the mid-2000s ensured that the league would be buried on the country's flagship sports media operation and the early years on Versus were truly painful in terms of the league's footprint. The subsequent growth of NBCSN has eased this factor somewhat.

ESPN gives every sign of saving big money for the next NFL contract – a likely reason for the increasingly brutal rounds of employee cutbacks – which would make resumption of NHL telecasts unlikely, except as a possible expansion of the local simulcasts on ESPN+. There are not many deep-pocketed media entities with cash to burn in the age of coronavirus, which makes a return to Comcast somewhat likely, especially with the chance to put additional games on the new Peacock streaming outlet (which will receive an astronomical raise in public awareness once The Office moves there on January 1). If NBC is willing to bump up their previous contract even a smidge, they could well retain the NHL, although a 10-year deal seems unlikely to be something that the league would want to be locked into in this climate.

Reaching the end of a national TV deal that provided poor cable exposure but good money (for the time) 10 years ago and has increasingly provided the opposite of each as the decade elapsed – and three decades into a national expansion that spread awareness of the sport and broadened its talent base in the US but has not resulted in the sport rising beyond niche status in the majority of US markets, the NHL has entered a crossroads as it enters the second of its two COVID-19-affected seasons.

That said, even a slightly better TV contract with slightly better exposure is just an improvement around the margins for the league – which, let's face it, is generally about as good as it ever gets for the NHL in the States. And that's not something that has to be the case. The league's base of young players is as talented (and charismatic, for media purposes) as any other in North American Big Four sports, if not more so. As such, the possibility continues to exist that the league can transcend its spot in Niche Nation. It's not a great possibility, but at least it hasn't lessened over time.

At the same time, the NHL can't continue to pursue the business-as-usual agenda of the Gary Bettman Era if it is going to rise in American public consciousness. There are a few steps that will be necessary if the league is to occupy a larger and more financially viable place in US society:

^ **Encourage third-party media engagement for NHL players.** This one is low-hanging fruit, because it costs nothing to achieve. The WWE, out of greed and stupidity, acted to quash the independent Twitch and Cameo channels of its "independent contractors" because they could not achieve any financial exploitation out of the deals. The NHL already doesn't get a penny out of such arrangements, so they have no incentive to squash them. The higher the profile that these players can achieve for themselves, especially among the youngest (and financially lucrative) consumers, the better.

^ **Make the marketing of top players your Manhattan Project.** We've beaten this drum for years. Imagine if Joe Montana and Jerry Rice were identical twins – think the NFL could have gotten mileage out of that? Well, Henrik and Daniel Sedin were identical twins who played (ON THE SAME TEAM, NO LESS!) for the better part of two decades and you'd be more likely to find them on the side of a milk carton than in any major commercial. There's a short-sighted mentality afoot that such efforts just accrue financially to the benefit of those featured in commercials, but that's not true. The league as a whole benefits from its superstars becoming celebrities and the fact that they can't see that is very disconcerting.

^ **Go back to the Olympics and stay there!** We've also beaten this drum for years. One of the worst excuses in sports has been the NHL owners deciding not to send players to the Olympics because of their whining about not making any money off of the games. And yet the quadrennial mainstream exposure that the players get dwarfs anything else that the league gets, ever. To admit that this exposure cannot be monetized in any way or exploited for the greater good of the league, frankly, is the height of incompetence. It may not be free advertising given what the league sacrifices out of its season every four years to make it happen, but it's worth so much more than the league "pays" for it and hopefully someday they'll learn that. And speaking of special hockey events: for outdoor games, more is less. The annual Winter Classic is special, notwithstanding the watering-down that the league has done with other stadium games. The short-term, cash-grab mentality attached to these games has to change. One of the first rules of economics is that the more there is of any special element, the less special it is.

The league does have a tremendous on-ice product right now with the kind of offensive production across the board and young talent necessary to hook in new fans. But sports leagues have to meet people where they are and if the NHL embraces this simple concept, they could grow far more than proliferation of their present short-term, cash-grab thinking will ever achieve for them.
