* The "Stat" column shows how each player performed on our standard deviation from the mean statistic in 2020-21 (stat details on Page 2).

* Relevant 2021-22 statistical categories are listed, along with rankings for each, the number of games played and rankings in the aforementioned "Stat" category.

Evaluating Production Across a Spectrum: Lessons of our Proprietary Ultimate Quantitative Baseline Stat

Our "UQB" category (Ultimate Quantitative Baseline) on our draft board calculates the standard deviation from the mean in all relevant hockey categories. In simple English, imagine a spectrum going across from left to right, with negative numbers on the left side, a "zero" in the middle and positive numbers on the right.

We utilize this statistic for football, baseball, basketball, hockey and NASCAR as well as hoops. For hockey, we use all of the standard fantasy categories listed on the draft board to factor in for this statistical compilation. A player's performance in each category is plotted on one of these spectrums, with the most valuable players putting up most of their numbers on the positive side. Then, we add up the totals of every category, positive and negative. By using this tool, we can identify not merely how they performed, but how valuable their performances were in each category. Truly, this statistic serves as the ultimate baseline for the previous season's production.

Don't Be That Guy

^ Don't sleep on stat-sheet fillers who aren't as well-publicized as some of the megastars. Examples include Gorgui Jieng, Patrick Beverley and Robert Covington.

^ Don't show up unprepared to deal with the specificities of your league's scoring system. Be prepared on all of the details.

^ Don't "punt" categories in a rotisserie league. You must try to be competitive in all areas in order to win.

^ Don't assemble too many injury question marks.

Suggested League Guidelines

We recommend that you hold your auction or serpentine-style draft with 10 owners, selecting 12 players (4 guards, 4 forwards, 2 centers). In case of an auction, use a financial system that allots an average of \$11 per player.

Our preferred style of play is head-to-head rotisserie, in which teams compete on a week-to-week head-up basis. Recommended categories are points, rebounds, assists, steals, blocks, 3-pointers, 3-point percentage, field goal percentage, free throw percentage and least turnovers. First place in each category would yield 10 points, second place 9 points, etc.

A rotating tiebreaker category should be utilized in the case of a 5-5 category tie. The starting lineup should consist of 2 guards, 2 forwards and 1 center.

College Hoops Fantasy Team Game Suggested Guidelines & Draft Board

^ A standard serpentine-style draft serves as the best place to begin.

^ The ideal distribution of talent would be as follows: 5 teams drafted by 8 owners, 6 teams drafted by 7 owners, 7 teams drafted by 6 owners or 8 teams drafted by 5 owners.

^ Points should be divided equally between success in the regular season/conference tournaments and in the NCAA tournament.

^ Regular season point distribution should come in the form of a "snapshot" of the Associated Press Top 25 poll on the following dates: January 3, January 17, January 31, February 14 and February 28. On those dates, points would be allocated in the following manner: 1st place (100 points), 2nd place (94 points), 3rd place (91 points), 4th place (88 points), 5th place (85 points), 6th place (78 points), 7th place (75 points), 8th place (72 points), 9th place (68 points), 10th place (65 points), 11th place (58 points), 12th place (55 points), 13th place (52 points), 14th place (48 points), 15th place (45 points), 16th place (40 points), 17th place (36 points), 18th place (32 points), 19th place (28 points), 20th place (25 points), 21st place (22 points), 22nd place (18 points), 23rd place (15 points), 24th place (12 points), 25th place (10 points). Additionally, 90 points are to be awarded to the winner of a regular season conference title and an additional 90 points to the winner of a conference title tournament.

^ The other half of the points, in the form of NCAA tournament points, are to be distributed as follows: 50 points for qualifying for the tournament, 100 points for one of your teams qualifying as a #1, #2, #3, #4 seed in any region, 40 points for qualifying as a #5, #6, #7 or #8 seed in any region, 40 points for winning a first-round tournament game, 75 points for winning a second-round tournament game, 150 points for winning a third-round tournament game, 175 for winning a regional final game, 250 points for winning a national semifinal game and 500 points for winning the national title.

NBA (Mildly Increasing) Parity: It's Fan-Tastic!

As observed in our most recent fantasy hoops guide, FANTASY HOOPS DRAFTOLOGY 2020, the 2020s look to be a more wide-open decade at the top of the NBA than we're used to seeing. Never have there been more than 12 different teams reaching the NBA Finals in a decade – and through the first two years of the Roaring Twenties, we've seen four different teams already.

In identifying both LA teams and Brooklyn as the only clear favorites for this past season (oh, how we should have stipulated the difference that injuries could make!), we established a second-tier of near-term contenders and a third-tier/oh-by-the-way list of teams who could make a move in the years to come, once these teams were about to fade. Atlanta just snuck onto that third tier. Phoenix? Not mentioned at all. Both teams managed to leapfrog their contemporaries in a manner that is so rarely seen. So while we were incorrect (obviously, with 20/20 hindsight) not to see them rising to the level of contention in the near term, we were correct that conditions are uncommonly ripe for such leaps to take place.

We also identified that the league is nearing a tipping point, where the stars who have dominated the NBA for many years would be supplanted by the next wave. With the rise of not just Phoenix and Atlanta, but also New York, Memphis and other playoff teams this past spring, it may have seemed that we were at that moment already. However, with all of the injured big stars of the NBA coming back next year (except, probably, Kawhi Leonard and Jamal Murray), what is more likely is that the league is going to be in for the kind of dynamic so rarely seen in any sport – an epic clash over the next 2-3 years between

teams led by the biggest stars of this generation and the biggest stars of the generation about to replace them. And then there are teams like Phoenix, with CP3 and Devin Booker, who blend elements of both.

Dating back to the 1980s when David Stern replaced the notion of marketing teams with the notion of marketing individual players, the league has believed that its greatest success comes from periods when a handful of teams led by megastars – ideally, in their mind, "glamorous franchises" – compete exclusively for titles. The guess here is that the league is going to find out, to their great joy, that they were mistaken. With as many as ten legitimate potential title contenders next year (count them out: Milwaukee, Brooklyn, Atlanta, both LA squads, Phoenix, Denver, Dallas, Golden State and Utah – and that's not even counting Philly if they escape their Ben Simmons problem or Miami if they can get back to where they were a year ago), the NBA could be entering a period of greatly enhanced interest. Think about the likelihood of a matchup or two that wouldn't seem likely until the conference finals landing in the first round and the potential of every subsequent series being very interesting and competitive.

One factor in all of this, which we had forecast in our aforementioned article, is that the kind of star-stacking perfected by Kevin Durant is more difficult in this climate. When the biggest stars are more spread out – partially because there are more of them now, which helps account for the bigger roster of title contenders – the temptation to front-run to any one team dissipates because the notion of putting them over the top is far less assured. Essentially, it's the Self-Correcting-Anti-Bitch-Move-Syndrome!

No league ever approaches the NFL's once-stated ideal of parity through the notion that an upset could happen "on any given Sunday," much less the perennially top-heavy NBA. But this is as close as we've seen in decades, if ever, to a "barbarians storming the gates" scenario. And it will be glorious if it materializes.
