



# 2024 FDH NFL Post-Draft Rankings

Rankings are based on the predraft rankings of FDH Senior Editor Jason Jones in PRO FOOTBALL DRAFTOLOGY 2024:

NOTES: Teams are ranked in four categories: value accrued from players on the Jason Jones Big Board, value accrued from those picks plus the extent to which those teams addressed their most glaring needs, the percentage of team needs filled by players on the Jason Jones Big Board and the post-draft FDH Team Power Rankings. Additionally, remaining team needs are listed.

After the 2021 draft, teams had 5.03 holes on average, dropping to 4.97 in 2022, 4.44 in 2023 and all the way to 3.97 in 2024.

Teams had exactly 7 holes on average going into free agency in 2024 and 6.19 after that, a drop of only 13%. The drop to the post-draft 3.97 holes on average is a drop of 43% from the start of free agency and a drop of 35% from the start of the draft. For our purposes, holes are filled by using a pick in the first four rounds on a position of need. In short, the league as a whole has improved at filling needs in the draft over the past four years, thus increasing the price to be paid for teams that have not been as proficient.

In terms of draft value, any team scoring over 208.43 was above average and those below that number were below average.

In terms of tiers in our power rankings, we see the league as a large Bell Curve right now, with just a few teams at the top and the bottom.
