From April 25-27, 2024, Detroit hosts its first NFL Draft as its archrival Chicago sits at the top of the draft, the beneficiary of one of the great heists of all time when they victimized Carolina before the '23 Draft. QB Caleb Williams of USC is the top pick in this draft, the most highly-rated player at his position for years.

This draft also has arguably the most highly-touted non-QB for many years, Ohio State WR Marvin Harrison Jr. The rest of the top five figures to come from this cast: OTs Olu Fashanu of Penn State and Joe Alt of Notre Dame, edge rushers Dallas Turner of Alabama and Jared Verse of Florida State, QBs Drake Maye of North Carolina and Jayden Daniels of LSU, WRs Rome Odunze of Wash ington and Malik Nabers of LSU, TE Brock Bowers of Georgia and

THE TOP 75 PLAYERS IN PRO BASKETBALL HISTORY

The NBA's 75th Anniversary has prompted a wave of Best-Of lists, but few with the substance to reinforce the selections. Authors Rick Morris, Ben Chew and Russ Cohen came together to create a list of the top 75 pro basketball players ever, with evidence to justify the placement of each -- as well as biographical details, comparisons of various legends, little-known-but-interesting tidbits, what-if scenarios and much more. Additionally, the book includes our year-by-year ranking of the top players in pro basketball and rosters for hypothetical "Olympic Dream Teams" had they existed prior to 1992. This is a book that is crafted for sports fans who are interested in learning more about the rich history of pro basketball.

Draft Play-Along Game

We at FantasyDrafthelp.com have devised a contest to help you and your friends measure your acumen on Draft Day. It's the FantasyDrafthelp.com Mock Draft Game (credit to Fantasy Drafthelp.com contributor Bob Benak for inventing the game). Each participant submits a mock draft before the proceedings ... and then all parties compete in a separate "live draft competition."

Each board is scored separately, but the scores of the two are compiled to crown the Grand Champion of Draft Day. Here's the scoring system:

Picks #1-4 are weighted at one point apiece. Picks #5-8 are weighted at two points apiece. Picks #9-12 are weighted at three points apiece. Picks #13-16 are weighted at four points apiece. Picks #17-20 are weighted at five points apiece. Picks #21-24 are weighted at six points apiece. Picks #25-28 are weighted at seven points apiece. Picks #29-32 are weighted at eight points apiece

Players may "roll over" their picks from the completed mock draft to the live draft if a player remains on the board ... or they may cover themselves with another pick. Example: a player has Arizona taking Marvin Harrison Jr. with the #4 pick on the mock draft they turned in at the outset. That would count for two points if the pick is correct. If Harrison is still on the board when the Cards are on the clock, the player is not obligated to pick Harrison during the live draft. He may "roll over" the pick, choosing to try to win two points in both the live and completed mock draft categories. Or he may try to cover himself with another pick. For example, should he correctly pick Rome Odunze in the live draft part of the competition, he would gain the two points in the live draft but win no points in the completed mock draft part of the competition, in which he incorrectly picked Harrison. So strategy is at a premium during this competition. This game also puts great emphasis on correctly making picks later in the first round, when chances for success are the most difficult. Picking a player accurately in the later part of the first round on both the completed mock draft and the live mock draft can ensure a thrilling, come-from-behind victory. If you and your friends want to take your enjoyment of Draft Day to the next level by competing and strategizing along with the wizards of the NFL, try our game and enjoy!

2024 Rookie Class Fantasy Analysis

It's rare for rookies to earn first-round fantasy football status, but Bijan Robinson was a consensus pick in 2023. Almost exclusively throughout history, running backs such as Robinson were the only ones to end up there. But history might be made in 2024 with Ohio State WR Marvin Harrison Jr. potentially earning first-round value.

The other player at any skill position who rates as the best prospect at his position in several years is Georgia TE Brock Bowers. He will definitely slot in as a top tier player at his position immediately.

Others who could provide top-flight fantasy value in 2024 are WRs Rome Odunze of Washington, WR Malik Nabers of LSU and Keon Coleman of Florida State, with WRs Brian Thomas Jr of LSU, Adonai Mitchell of Texas, Xavier Legette of South Carolina, Ja'lynn Polk of Washington, Jalen McMillan of Washington and Ladd McConkey of Georgia as others of pretty good value potentially.

QB Caleb Williams of USC has such a high ceiling that it's conceivable that he could become a top tier fantasy passer in Year One, although it's more likely that he'd be a fantasy backup. Others who could join him on that level are Drake Maye of North Carolina, Jayden Daniels of LSU and Michael Penix of Washington.

First Look Ahead to 2025 Pro Football Draft

The 2025 NFL Draft has two strong candidates to be the top pick in the draft presently, given the position that generally occupies that spot: QBs Shedeur Sanders of Colorado and Quinn Ewers of Texas. And it should be no surprise that in this era of NIL, the transfer portal and the rich getting richer in terms of the top programs, most of the candidates to go in the top half of the first round have teammates who could very well join them there. The other Buffalo, of course, is dynamic potential two-way player CB/WR Travis Hunter and the other Longhorns are OT/OG Kelvin Banks and DE Ethan Burke.

The only candidates to go in the Top 16 who don't have teammates presently likely to join them are DE Landon Jackson of Arkansas, DE Patrick Payton of Florida State, CB Benjamin Morrison of Notre Dame and WR Luther Burden III of Missouri. Otherwise, school-by-school, here are the present candidates:

Georgia: QB Carson Beck, DE Mykel Williams, S Malachi Starks, CB Daylen Everette and OT Earnest Greene III.

LSU: OT Will Campbell, OLB Harold Perkins.

Michigan: DT Mason Graham and CB Will Johnson.

Mississippi: DT Walter Nolen and DE Princely Umanmielen.

Ohio State: CB Jordan Hancock, DT Tyleik Williams and CB Denzel Burke.

Oklahoma: LB Danny Stutsman, CB Gentry Williams. Penn State: QB Drew Allar, OLB Abdul Carter.

Why Value Matters In **Fantasy & Pro Sports Drafts** WINTER

On our FANTASYDRAFTHELP.COM INSIDER webcasts, we've discussed this point many times, but we're continually reminded of the need to readdress it: the very real link between fantasy sports drafts and the so-called real kind.

Years ago, when the Buffalo Bills selected Donte Whitner with the eighth overall pick at a time when he was considered a fringe Top 20 player at best, FDH Senior Editor Jason Jones and I ridiculed the pick in a real-time webcast.

We explained that Marv Levy, who was new to the Buffalo front office, clearly had no concept of value. Top10 picks must become franchise players at their positions. If, for whatever reason, you are fixated on a player unworthy of the draft slot, trade back and obtain the value collectively, through the desired player and additional picks, but always get value for your pick.

And if a Top 10 pick must become a franchise player, then a Top 5 pick must become one of the elite players in the league. For a team like the Browns that squandered numerous draft picks under the auspices of such luminaries as Butch Davis, Shoebox Pete Garcia, Eric Mangini, Mike Lombardi, Ray Farmer and Sashi Brown, the tenth overall pick in the draft has to be a home run and cannot be used on a player not deemed safe enough by the collective brainpower of NFL personnel people. There is no margin for error.

We at FDH don't have to educate skilled fantasy sports owners on the concept of value. This is something they know, or at the very least intuit, as they go through their draft or auction preparation. We always say that you win by obtaining value with every pick. While that ideal is almost impossible, you have to come as close as you can. That means that your high picks have to perform at the level forecasted and your mid-round and lower-round picks must outperform their draft slots. We have always emphasized that the same precept holds true in professional sports drafts. Winning organizations make the most of their draft picks and they know how to proceed in a measured fashion. They do not panic.
