THE TOP 75 PLAYERS IN PRO BASKETBALL HISTORY

The NBA's 75th Anniversary has prompted a wave of Best-Of lists, but few with the substance to reinforce the selections. Authors Rick Morris, Ben Chew and Russ Cohen came together to create a list of the top 75 pro basketball players ever, with evidence to justify the placement of each -- as well as biographical details, comparisons of various legends, little-known-but-interesting tidbits, what-if scenarios and much more. Additionally, the book includes our year-by-year ranking of the top players in pro basketball and rosters for hypothetical "Olympic Dream Teams" had they existed prior to 1992. This is a book that is crafted for sports fans who are interested in learning more about the rich history of pro basketball.

Draft Play-Along Game

We at FantasyDrafthelp.com have devised a contest to help you and your friends measure your acumen on Draft Day. It's the FantasyDrafthelp.com Mock Draft Game (credit to Fantasy Drafthelp.com contributor Bob Benak for inventing the game). Each participant submits a mock draft before the proceedings ... and then all parties compete in a separate "live draft competition."

Each board is scored separately, but the scores of the two are compiled to crown the Grand Champion of Draft Day. Here's the scoring system:

Picks #1-4 are weighted at one point apiece.
 Picks #5-8 are weighted at two points apiece.
 Picks #9-12 are weighted at three points apiece.
 Picks #13-16 are weighted at four points apiece.
 Picks #17-20 are weighted at five points apiece.
 Picks #21-24 are weighted at six points apiece.
 Picks #25-28 are weighted at seven points apiece.
 Picks #29-32 are weighted at eight points apiece

Players may "roll over" their picks from the completed mock draft to the live draft if a player remains on the board ... or they may cover themselves with another pick. Example: a player has New England taking Tetairoa McMillan with the #4 pick on the mock draft they turned in at the outset. That would count for one point if the pick is correct. If McMillan is still on the board when the Patriots are on the clock, the player is not obligated to pick McMillan during the live draft. He may "roll over" the pick, choosing to try to win two points in both the live and completed mock draft categories. Or he may try to cover himself with another pick. For example, should he correctly pick Abdul Carter in the live draft part of the competition, he would gain the one point in the live draft but win no points in the completed mock draft part of the competition, in which he incorrectly picked McMillan. So strategy is at a premium during this competition. This game also puts great emphasis on correctly making picks later in the first round, when chances for success are the most difficult. Picking a player accurately in the later part of the first round on both the completed mock draft and the live mock draft can ensure a thrilling, come-from-behind victory. If you and your friends want to take your enjoyment of Draft Day to the next level by competing and strategizing along with the wizards of the NFL, try our game and enjoy!

2025 Rookie Class Fantasy Analysis

In 2023, Bijan Robinson earned first-round value in many fantasy drafts – and Marvin Harrison Jr. did the same in 2024. In 2025, there may very well be two rookies who earn first-round fantasy consideration: Boise State RB Ashton Jeanty and Arizona WR Tetairoa McMillan. Both are capable of potentially becoming elite performers as rookies, although McMillan's value is of course going to have something to do with the QB on his new team.

As has been the case in every recent draft, WR fantasy depth is better than anything that you'll find in the backfield. Luther Burden III of Missouri is projected to be drafted within 10-15 spots of McMillan. Emeka Egbuka seems certain to become the latest in a long line of top contributors from Wide Receiver U, aka Ohio State. Others with a decent chance of contributing as rookies are Tre Harris of Mississippi, Jalen Royals of Utah State, Isaiah Bond and Matthew Golden of Texas, Elic Ayomanor of Stanford, Tory Horton of Colorado State, Tai Felton of Maryland and Xavier Restrepo of Miami. Travis Hunter of Colorado seems certain to play a lot of WR, but your mileage may vary on where you want to draft him.

Other top RBs in this draft class are Omarion Hampton of North Carolina, Kaleb Johnson of Iowa and Quinshon Judkins and TreVeyon Henderson of Ohio State. TEs Tyler Warren of Penn State and Colston Loveland of Michigan could become fantasy starters in Year 1. QBs Shedeur Sanders of Colorado and Cam Ward of Miami are less likely.

First Look Ahead to 2026 Pro Football Draft

The clear leader in the clubhouse to be the top pick in the 2026 NFL Draft is the test-tube baby himself, Arch Manning, Texas QB. But a few other passers are expected to go high also, including Garrett Nussmeier of LSU, Drew Allar of Penn State (notwithstanding their recent history for churning out NFL QB busts) and LaNorris Sellers of South Carolina.

There's plenty of top edge talents, including TJ Parker and Peter Woods of Clemson, Keldric Faulk of Auburn, Suntarine Perkins of Mississippi, Harold Perkins of LSU, Mateo Uzagalelei of Oregon, Rubeen Bain Jr of Miami and Anthony Hill Jr of Texas.

Such a crop requires a fleet of top OT talents to protect the quarterbacks and this class has a few: Francis Mauigoa of Miami, Kayden Proctor of Alabama, Austin Barber of Florida and Spencer Fano of Utah.

There's also a strong crop of defensive backs: S Caleb Downs of Ohio State, S Keon Sabb of Alabama, CB/S Javon Kilgore of South Carolina and CB Domani Jackson of Alabama.

Why Value Matters In Fantasy & Pro Sports Drafts

On our FANTASYDRAFTHelp.COM INSIDER webcasts, we've discussed this point many times, but we're continually reminded of the need to readdress it: the very real link between fantasy sports drafts and the so-called real kind.

Years ago, when the Buffalo Bills selected Donte Whitner with the eighth overall pick at a time when he was considered a fringe Top 20 player at best, FDH Senior Editor Jason Jones and I ridiculed the pick in a real-time webcast.

We explained that Marv Levy, who was new to the Buffalo front office, clearly had no concept of value. Top 10 picks must become franchise players at their positions. If, for whatever reason, you are fixated on a player unworthy of the draft slot, trade back and obtain the value collectively, through the desired player and additional picks, but always get value for your pick.

And if a Top 10 pick must become a franchise player, then a Top 5 pick must become one of the elite players in the league. For a team like the Browns that squandered numerous draft picks under the auspices of such luminaries as Butch Davis, Shoebox Pete Garcia, Eric Mangini, Mike Lombardi, Ray Farmer and Sashi Brown, the tenth overall pick in the draft has to be a home run and cannot be used on a player not deemed safe enough by the collective brainpower of NFL personnel people. There is no margin for error.

We at FDH don't have to educate skilled fantasy sports owners on the concept of value. This is something they know, or at the very least intuit, as they go through their draft or auction preparation. We always say that you win by obtaining value with every pick. While that ideal is almost impossible, you have to come as close as you can. That means that your high picks have to perform at the level forecasted and your mid-round and lower-round picks must outperform their draft slots. We have always emphasized that the same precept holds true in professional sports drafts. Winning organizations make the most of their draft picks and they know how to proceed in a measured fashion. They do not panic.
